# **KEY SCRIPTURES**

## 1 John 1:9

If we <u>confess</u> our sins, he is faithful and just to <u>forgive us</u> our sins and to <u>cleanse us</u> from all unrighteousness.

# 2 Chronicles 7:14

... if my people, who are called by my name, will <u>humble themselves</u> and <u>pray</u> and <u>seek my face</u> and <u>turn from their wicked ways</u>, then will I hear from heaven and will forgive their sin and will <u>heal</u> their land.

## 2 Chronicles 7:14

Humble repentance is a necessary stage in God's ultimate aim to forgive and heal. Another essential element in the process is God's promise to hear prayer.

## Psalm 51:10-17

Create in me a <u>pure heart</u>, O God, and <u>renew</u> a steadfast spirit within me.

Do not cast me from your presence or take your Holy Spirit from me.

<u>Restore</u> to me the joy of your salvation and grant me a willing spirit, to sustain me.

Then I will teach transgressors your ways, and sinners will turn back to you.

Save me from bloodguilt, O God, the God who saves me, and my tongue will sing of your righteousness.

O Lord, open my lips, and my mouth will declare your praise.

You do not delight in sacrifice, or I would bring it; you do not take pleasure in burnt offerings.

The sacrifices of God are a <u>broken spirit</u>; <u>a broken and contrite heart</u>, <u>O God, you will not despise</u>.
